The Rest Of The Story

It is quite amazing that we drive into South Dallas to go to Church with Pastor Russel.

First, let me describe the neighborhood.

Poverty. South Dallas is the most neglected neighborhood in a neglected area of Dallas.

When you arrive at the Church the first thing you will see is that it is in a strip mall. One unit of a strip mall. It would seem to be impossibly small to house a Church - and you are probably right. The other thing you will notice is that the street parking does not have any garbage on it! It is clean!!

Pastor Russel likes to tell the story of how we ended up in his Church. We met at a Cru event and he invited us to come to Church. We planned to be there the next Sunday. He stops and takes a breath. Then says, "and you know what, they did." He continues to say that "I have had lots of people say they will come to Church, but we actually did." When we are in town we are there maybe two Sundays a month.

So, you may ask, why does he stay in this little tiny Church in a neighborhood overrun with poverty.

I think the answer is pretty simple. He was born there. He lived in an apartment one block from the Church and he sold drugs on the corner. It was where he was arrested. He took so much from this neighborhood, now he wants to give something back.

He is the most caring, generous, loving person I have ever met.

It is easy to be critical of content, his reading ability or the flow of his message. But the 10 or 20 people who sit in the chairs on Sunday mornings go away having learned one thing.

We know that we are loved!
